I am pleased to inform you that your laboratory has been validated by the Chinese Taipei Bureau of Standards, Metrology, and Inspection (BSMI) under the Asia Pacific Economic Cooperation Mutual Recognition Arrangement (APEC MRA). Your laboratory is now provisionally designated to act as a Conformity Assessment Body (CAB) under Appendix B, Phase I Procedures, of the APEC MRA between the American Institute in Taiwan (AIT) and the Taipei Economic and Cultural Representative Office (TECRO) in the United States. This MRA covers equipment subject to Electro-Magnetic Compatibility (EMC) requirements. The names of all validated and nominated laboratories will be posted on the NIST website at <http://ts.nist.gov/mra>.

You may submit test data to BSMI to verify that the equipment to be imported into Chinese Taipei satisfies the applicable EMC requirements using the following guidelines:

Your assigned BSMI number is **SL2-IN-E-068R**. You must use this number when sending test reports to BSMI.

BSMI requires that the entity making application for the approval of regulated equipment must make such application in person at their Taipei office.

BSMI requires that every test report must accompany a cover sheet that can be accessed at our above noted website.

Your designation will remain in force as long as your A2LA accreditation remains valid for the CNS 13438.

BSMI requested the names of the authorized signatories who are authorized to sign the test reports. Please send this information immediately to your accreditor (A2LA) with a request to forward the information to NVCASE program at NIST.
